

# A Big Thank You from the Congress Organizing Committee!



### 1) Email Address Sharing Opt-Out Deadline for Congress Report

One of the principal objectives of IUFRO is to facilitate networking with fellow researchers around the world. Improved networking is one of the prime benefits from attending an IUFRO World Congress. Email is now the standard tool for networking. To foster networking among Congress participants, the CSC shared emails of presenters in the book of abstracts that delegates received upon registration. The COC intends to print the email addresses of all delegates in the 2014 Congress Report, as was done in the 2010 Congress Final Report. We will remove the "@" character so that web-crawlers cannot harvest the addresses. If you do not want your email address to appear in the 2014 Congress Report—and forego the ability for colleagues to network with you about your research—then you must opt out by **November 14** by completing this short survey https://www.surveymonkey.com/s/GW73KKP
