- Text format:
 - B5, font *Times New Roman* size 11pt; all margins 2 cm;
 - Paragraphs in the text should be divided by a single empty line;
 - Numeration of titles and subtitles according to the hierarchy, e.g. 1. , 1.1. , 1.1.1.
 - Referencing to the literature in the text should be made in the following way: (Surname of the author(s), year of publication);
 - Literature sources list at the end of the paper should be arranged in alphabetic order, e.g.: Surname, Initial(s). (year of publication), Title of publication, Title of Journal/ Monograph/ Conference, Publisher, Place, p. number of pages.
