Multiple Forest Outputs: Silviculture, Accounting and Managerial Economics



Viterbo (Italy), 19nd-21st May, 2011

CONTEXT, OBJECTIVE AND THEMES

Forests are a multifunctional context, provider of goods (wood and non woods products) services (recreational, etc), and externalities (landscape etc). Forest management must be oriented to enhance this package mixed goods.

Sustainable forest management covers a wide range of management approaches. Its continuum spectrum includes an intensive managerial approach to maximise timber production, a conservative approaches which sustain the multifunctional use of forest, where timber and ecological functions are a conjoint production, and finally a preservative approach to maximise ecological function only, excluding timber production at all.

The main provocative questions that SFM sets to the forest researchers, and we suggest to be adopted as main themes for the International Symposium in Viterbo, are:

- how can we define the best silvicultural system to achieve these aims for each kind forest?
- what are the impacts on forest firms accounting?
- what are the results on managerial economic?
- what tools can be used to sustain forest multiple use?
- what are the experiences that countries have stored up to now?

All researchers who wish to make a contribution to the themes of this International Symposium are welcome.

B) Travel

How to get Viterbo

From International Fiumicino Airport to Viterbo

1° option:

- 1i) direct train direction to Roma Termini Station (Leonardo's Train, 1h – no stop).
- 2) a Roma Termini Station take train direction Orte (in Orte stopped train with direction Firenze, or Ancona, 35-40 min. N.B. Please do not use EUROSTAR).
- 3) in Orte Station you have two possibilites
 - 3a) by train direction to Viterbo Porta Fiorentina (final destination) (45 min.)
 - 3b) by bus direction Viterbo. Bus Station is located in front to the main entrance to the train station (30 min);



2° option

1) slow train direction to Roma Ostiense (final destination) or Orte or Fara Sabina (Stops at all stations). Change in Roma Ostiense Station.

2) in Roma Ostiense Station take train direction Viterbo Porta Fiorentina (final destination, 1h+40min).

How to get to the conference site

For people who book hotels in Viterbo historical center, they have two options:

a) by bus. People can use local bus, direction to Riello, line Bus station is located in Piazza del Sacratio, but they can ask to the hotel receptionist to have information about the closest bus stop.

b) on foot. From Viterbo centre to zona Riello (Facoltà di Agraria), the distance is 800-1.000 metres long from Viterbo historical centre.
