Multiple Forest Outputs: Silviculture, Accounting and Managerial Economics



Viterbo (Italy), 19th-21st May, 2011



CONTEXT, OBJECTIVE AND THEMES

Forests provide a multitude of values to society, ranging from commodities such as wood products and traditional non-market uses such recreation, to values often considered externalities such as clean air and water. Forest management must be developed in such a way that these diverse values are enhanced.

Sustainable forest management covers a wide range of management approaches. The spectrum includes an intensive managerial approach to maximize timber production, conservative approaches which sustain the multifunctional use of forests, where timber and ecological functions are jointly produced, and finally a preservative approach to maximize ecological function and excluding timber production completely.

The main provocative questions that SFM provides for forest researchers, and that we suggest to be adopted as main themes for the International Symposium in Viterbo, are:

- How can we identify the best silvicultural systems to achieve these aims for different forest types?
- What are the impacts on forest accounting?
- What are the effects on managerial economics?
- What tools can be used to sustain forests and their multiple uses?
- How do the experiences with SFM differ by country?

B) Travel

How to get to Viterbo

From International Fiumicino Airport to Viterbo

1° option:

- 1) Direct train to Roma Termini Station (Leonardo's Train, 1h – no stop).
- 2) At Roma Termini Station take train to Orte (N.B. Please do not take EUROSTAR).
- 3) At Orte Station you have two possibilities:
 - 3a) by train to Viterbo Porta Fiorentina (final destination) (45 min.);
 - 3b) by bus to Viterbo. Bus Station is located in front to the main entrance of the train station (30 min);

2° option:

- 1) Slow train to Roma Ostiense (final destination) or Orte or Fara Sabina (Stops at all stations). Change in Roma Ostiense Station.
- 2) At Roma Ostiense Station take train to Viterbo Porta Fiorentina (final destination, 1h+40min).

How to get to the conference site

People who book hotels in Viterbo historical center have two options:

- a) by bus. Use local bus, direction Riello. Bus station is located in Piazza del Sacratio, please ask the hotel receptionist for information about the closest bus stop.
- b) on foot. From Viterbo centre to zona Riello (Facoltà di Agraria), the distance is 800-1.000 metres long from Viterbo historical centre.
