Firenze, March 16th, 2011

Dear forest pathologists,

it is with great pleasure we officially invite you to attend the 13th International Conference of the International Union of Forestry Research Organization, Working Party 7.02.01 "Root and Butt Rot of Forest Trees" scientific meeting, visiting the Italian peninsula from September 4th until Sept 10th, 2011.

1- General information - The Conference will start in <u>Firenze</u> later on will move to the Dolomite mountains where will be possible to continue with sessions an also to visit conifer woods. The Conference will be preceded by an optional PRE-CONFERENCE, field trip in ROMA.

Conference welcome and registration will be organized at <u>Casa della Creatività</u> - Vicolo di Santa Maria Maggiore, 1 Firenze, near the Cathedral, in the evening of Sunday 4th where you are invited to have a welcome cocktail.

The first session of the Conference will start at 8.30 on September 5th in the Conference room in Firenze (Via San Gallo, 25) At the Auditorium close to the <u>Cenacolo di Santa Apollonia</u>. Sessions will continue on September 6th in the same place. On September 7th we will move by coach northward to Dolomite area, stopping along the way in S. Michele all'Adige (Trento) where we will visit the <u>FEM</u> <u>Research Centre</u> and its historic wine cellar. Along the travel we will enjoy the view of the Dolomites landscape, villages and mountains (the beauty and the geological diversity, the botany, and the landscape itself were decisive in the international commission of experts of UNESCO to declare in 2009 the Dolomites as a World Heritage site) until in <u>San Martino di Castrozza</u> where we will stay for three more days. On September 8th the meeting will continue in San Martino with a full session day. We will spent the next day, September 9th, visiting the <u>Natural Park of "Paneveggio Pale di San</u> <u>Martino"</u> and finally will end at approximately 12.00 on September 10th after the closing session.

Getting There and Away – For your travel plans consider to reach Firenze directly by fly but also by train from Milano, Roma or Venice. All cities have good <u>train connections</u> to Firenze. No transportation will be provided from Roma to Firenze for those interested in the optional preexcursion near Roma.

The <u>Firenze Airport</u> is located 4 km from the center of the city. A taxi can make the trip in 15 minutes, and the Bus between the airport and Santa Maria Novella railway station takes 20 minutes. Bus service has a frequency of 30 min.

Firenze Train Station - Florence's central station is called Firenze Santa Maria Novella (look for signs announcing "Firenze SMN"). The train station is located in the northwest corner of central Florence, within convenient walking distance of most Florence tourist attractions (as well as <u>Cenacolo</u> <u>di Santa Apollonia</u>).

After the meeting end in **San Martino di Castrozza**, it will be possible back to Firenze with the reserved coach (included in the registration fee) or to reach Venezia (2 hours distance by Bus service, about € 20.00; INFO <u>http://www.brusutti.com/Default.aspx?lang=2</u>; <u>http://www.sanmartino.com/</u>).

Optional Pre-Conference Field Trip

For those who are interested to know the site where the North American *Heterobasidion irregulare* is spreading, a pre-conference field trip will be organize on September 3rd, starting at 9.30 am (pick up will be in the center of Roma, registered people will be informed by mail separately). The excursion will end approximately at 16.30 pm. A box-lunch and beverages will be provided to attendees.

Attendees will have 15-20 minutes for their oral presentations including a couple of minutes for questions. Following the tradition of last conference in California, Poster presentations are substituted by short oral presentations. Short oral presentations will be 5 minutes long and will include a maximum of 5 slides. Questions will be asked at the end of a session rather than at the end of each presentation.

Priority for short talks will be given to students who are not giving a full presentation, followed by attendees who are not given a long talk, and finally short talks may be used as a second presentation by attendees who already give a full talk. When submitting abstracts for both long and short talks, attendees need to select the focus area of their presentation. Please include first and second best selections among the following focus areas:

- 1 Genomics and plant-pathogen interactions;
- 2 Ecology;
- 3 Actiology and epidemiology;
- 4 Systematic, taxonomy, and phylogeography;
- 5 Population genetics;
- 6- New reports, diagnostics, and research applications of diagnostic methods:
- 7- Disease management and control

<u>Abstracts</u> of presentations should not exceed 1,600 characters, including title, authors and all publication information.

Abstracts need to be sent to <u>iufroO7rbr-italy@unifi.it</u> no later than **31st May**, **2011**. Emails need to include – IUFRO ABSTRACT – "Erik Smith" (name 1st Author) in the subject as a file name.

The conference organizers will try to accommodate everybody, but some long talks may be transformed into short, if needed.

The <u>Conference Proceedings</u> will not feature full papers, but rather **extended abstracts** with different size for <u>Long</u> or <u>Short presentations</u> (ex posters). <u>Long presentations -</u> will not exceed 6322 characters, including title, authors, all publication information, and a maximum of eight references. A maximum of four items, between tables and black/white figures, can be added to the script. All figures and/or tables, including legends, should be formatted to fit into two thirds of one page, maximum.

<u>Short presentations</u> (ex-posters) will not exceed 3166 characters, including title, authors, all publication information, and a maximum of four references. A maximum of two items, between tables and figures, can be added to the script. All figures and/or tables, including legends, should be formatted to fit into one third of a page, maximum.

Who will give oral presentation can present either a Long or Short. Extended Abstract Before submitting your extended abstract, please ensure with the organizers it has been approved for a long presentation.

Your contributions as **Extended abstracts** should be ready at Registration desk in Firenze <u>Extended abstracts</u> should be sent to <u>iufro07rbr-italy@unifi.it</u> and the file called - IUFRO EXTENDED ABSTRACT LONG (or SHORT) - Erik Smith (name 1st Author) - in the subject and as a file name.
