Public Transport:

By flight: Stockholm-Arlanda Airport is close to Uppsala. To get to Uppsala, there are several airport shuttles and trains every hour from Arlanda Airport. The train departs directly in the airport between Terminal 3 and 4. The flygbussen has the number 801 and departs directly outside the terminals. Leave the bus at the final destination central station in Uppsala.

By train: Uppsala central station is well connected with Stockholm and whole Uppland, details for your travel plans you can find at the webpage: http://www.sj.se/.

From Uppsala cental station: From Uppsala central station you can take the local bus (No 20 in the direction Graneberg or 110 or 115 in the direction Ultuna). Leave the bus at the stop Polacksbacken. Directly in front of the University is a roundabout, there you head downhill in the direction of Eklundshovsvägen. After 400m Eklundshof appears on the left hand.
